

Temporary Pressure Buildup Summary
Eddy "GK" State #2

During the 90 day disqualifying period ending July, 1984, the subject well was closed in 52 days by El Paso Natural Gas Company due to lack of market demand. Total production for the well during this time was 2545 MCF (at a pressure base of 14.73 psi) over 40 days, yielding an average rate of 63.6 MCFPD. During the 90 day period July, 1983 through September, 1983, the well operated at maximum deliverability, producing 4318 MCF over 92 days (no non-producing days) for an average of 46.9 MCFPD (14.73 psi P.B.). This clearly indicates that the well would not have exceeded 60 MCFPD had it been open to sales the entire 90-day disqualifying period May, 1984 through July, 1984.
