
Concerning recent correspondance and 'phone conversations regarding the completion of 4 point tests on the above subject well.

As explained in our telephone conversation this apparently a very marginal well. The well has been acidized and sand fraced. We have experienced considerably difficulty in getting the well cleaned up in view of the excessive line pressure on El Paso Natural Gas Company's transmission lines which is approxmiately 950 Lbs.

While the well has been improving somewhat, we have been able to produce only about 200 MCFPD plus 2 barrels of condensate and 3-5 barrels of frac fluid per day into the line. Rather than blow to the air and waste the gas and liquids we have attempted a clean-up into the line, hence the delay in being able to complete 4 point tests.

El Paso assures us they will have a new loop in their line in the next thirty days with expectations of reducing their line pressure to approxmiately 550 Pounds. This should aid us considerably in the evaluation of the well. When this has been accomplished we will submit the test you have requested at the earliest possible date.
