

1. EXISTING ROADS:

- A. Exhibit A is a portion of New Mexico highway map showing the location of the proposed well. The location is approximately 20 miles east of Artesia, New Mexico. Travel from Artesia on U. S. Highway 82 until you come to N. M. Highway 360. Turn south on this highway and travel approximately 5 miles. You should be at a paved intersection. Turn west (right) and travel for about 1 1/2 miles. Our proposed location is due north about 2000 feet.

2. PLANNED ACCESS ROADS:

- A. Exhibit B shows the portion of road that will have to be built. This new road will be 12' wide and we do not plan to use caliche on it at this time.

3. LOCATION OF EXISTING WELLS:

- A. There are numerous producing wells in this section. They are color coded blue. There are also several dry holes and they are color coded brown. One of these dry holes is located in the same unit as our proposed Depco Federal #1. Please see Exhibit B for details.

4. LOCATION OF TANK BATTERIES, ETC.:

- A. In the event we drill a producing well, all production facilities will be located on the pad that will be built. Plat of production facilities on Exhibit D.

5. LOCATION AND TYPE OF WATER SUPPLY:

- A. Water will be obtained from commercial sources.

6. SOURCE OF CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS:

- A. In the event we need caliche there is a federal pit located in the SW/SW of Section 8, Township 18S, Range 29E.

7. METHODS OF HANDLING WASTE MATERIAL:

- A. Waste will be buried in reserve pits at a depth of 24". The well site will be cleaned of all waste and this will be done within 30 days after completion of the well.

8. ANCILLARY FACILITIES:

- A. None required.

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
