

Proserpio is also the principal denizen of nearby ridges.

Cultural Resources

No archaeological sites were recorded during HMAS' reconnaissance. One isolated manifestation, located south of Hondo's proposed well area, was observed. It consists of 1 quartzite core, 2 quartzite secondary decortication flakes, and an attendant light scatter of burned caliche pebbles. Archaeologically, this area is, albeit poorly known, appears to host a dense concentration of sites. This is particularly true of the country to the south. Sites appear to be of Archaic age although this is conjectured owing to an absence of diagnostic artifacts.

Recommendations

HMAS recommends clearance for Hondo's proposed Trigg-Jennings Federal Com. Well No. 1 and associated access road and suggests that work-related activities proceed according to existing plans.
