T.D. 3015' Lime. Prep to drill ahead. MIRU a Rotary and spudded a 17-1/2" hole @ 1730 MDT on 10-21-81 and drilled to a T.D. of 300' with no returns. Ran and set 9 jts. (283.60') 13-3/8" OD 48# H40 csg. @ 300' and cemented with 300 sacks of Class C thickset w/10# Gilsonite, 1/4# Flocele & 2% CaCl₂/sack + 350 sacks of Class C w/2% CaCl₂ cement. PD @ 1440 MDT on 10-22-81. Cement did not circulate to surface. WOC 4 hrs. PU 1" & tagged cement @ 150'. Pumped 200 sacks of Class C w/4% CaCl₂ in 4 stages. WOC 2 hrs. between stages. No fill. Pumped 100 sacks of Class C w/4% CaCl₂ cement + 2 yds. of Pea gravel in 2 stages. Circulated 25 sacks of cement to surface. WOC 18 hrs. Tested 13-3/8" casing to 1000# - OK. USGS was notified but did not witness. Drilled a 12 1/4" hole to a T.D. of 3015' in lime. Ran and set 25 jts. (1080.77') 8-5/8" OD 32# K55 and 45 jts. (1917.89') 8-5/8" OD 24# K55 casing @ 3015' and cemented with 1450 sacks of HOWCO lite + 1/4# Flocele, 5# Gilsonite & 2% CaCl₂/sack + 300 sacks of Class C w/2% CaCl₂ cement. PD @ 1815 MST on 10-30-81. Cement circulated to surface. WOC 18 hrs. Tested 8-5/8" casing to 1500# - OK.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations; and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
