

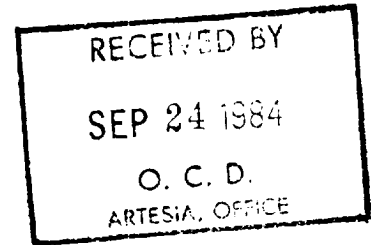


Gentlemen:

Attached is a copy of a letter, with attachments, dated September 4, 1984 which was sent to all gas well operators producing into Phillips Petroleum Company's Artesia Plant Gathering Systems. The letter advises that effective 9-17-84 pipeline proration would commence on all gas wells.

At the time of producer notification we were not aware of the connection of your Government "AM" No. 1 well (Meter Station 075074) to the Artesia system. This is to advise that your well has been added to the list of wells to be shut out during this proration period. You will be advised when production may be resumed.
