

- C. The reserve pits will be plastic lined.
- D. A 400' X 400' area has been staked and flagged.

10. PLANS FOR RESTORATION OF THE SURFACE.

- A. After finishing drilling and/or completion operations, all equipment and other material not needed for further operations will be removed. The location will be cleaned of all trash and junk to leave the wellsite in as aesthetically pleasing a condition as possible.
- B. Unguarded pits, if any, containing fluids will be fenced until they have been filled.
- C. If the proposed well is non-productive, all rehabilitation and/or vegetation requirements of the operator-landowner agreement will be complied with and will be accomplished as expeditiously as possible. All pits will be filled leveled within 90 days after abandonment.

11. OTHER INFORMATION.

- A. Topography: The land surface in the vicinity of the wellsite is nearly level. The immediate area of the wellsite is discussed above in paragraph 9B.
- B. Flora and Fauna: The vegetation cover consists of various grasses, tarbush, broom snakeweed, greasewood and miscellaneous desert growth. No wildlife was observed but the wildlife in the area probably includes those typical of semi-arid desert land. The area is used for cattle grazing.
- C. There are no ponds, lakes or rivers in the area.
- D. There are inhabited dwellings in the vicinity of the proposed well. Bill Kennedy's ranch house is approximately 1 mile NE.
- E. Surface Ownership: The wellsite is on private surface with federal minerals.
- F. There is no evidence of any archaeological, historical or cultural sites in the area.
