#### FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Harvey E. Yates Company, seeks approval of an unorthodox gas well location for its Travis Ohio State Com Well No. 1 to be drilled 760 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West line of Section 13, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, to test the Wolfcamp and Pennsylvanian formations, Eddy County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the S/2 of said Section 13 is to be dedicated to the well.
- (4) That a well at said unorthodox location is necessitated to enable applicant to drill at a standard Upper Pennsylvanian oil well location.
- (5) That no offset operator objected to the proposed unorthodox location.
