- (B) PLACE CIBP @ 2546' 30' ABOVE TOP PERFS 2576-90' (17 HOLES), PLACE 35' CEMENT PLUG ON TOP OF CIBP (IN 4 1/2" 9.5# APPROX 3 SACKS)
- (C) FILL 4 1/2" CASING WITH 9.0 LB/GAL MUD LADDEN FLUID TO 454' SPOT 100' CEMENT PLUG 50' ABOVE AND BELOW THE POINT WHERE 8 5/8 IS SET (404') TOP OF CEMENT @ 354' FILL REMAINING 4 1/2 WITH 9 LB PER GAL MUD LADDEN FLUID WITH A 50' CEMENT PLUG TO SURFACE.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
