Drilled to total depth of 3700 feet in lime with 7 7/8 inch bit at 1:00 P.M. August 14, 1983. Ran Schlumberger Gamma Ray, Dual Laterolog, Neutron, and Density logs. Shot sidewall cores at 3366', 3368', 3370', 3432', 3436', 3440', 3192', 3194', 3196', 3308'. Ran 91 joints 4 1/2", 11.6#, J-55 casing with float collar and guide shoe, 3688'; set at 3698'. Cemented with 500 gals. Flocheck, 1050 sacks Howco lite with 1/4# Flocele and 15# salt per sack, and 350 sacks 50-50 poz with 6# salt per sack. Cement in place at 12:00 noon, August 15, 1983. Circulated out 204 sacks excess cement. Tested casing with 1500 psi for 30 minutes - O.K. closed in well head and released rig. Allowed cement to set before initiating completion operations on August 22, 1983.

Instructions

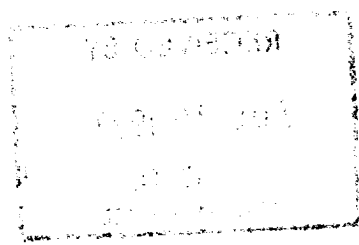
General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
