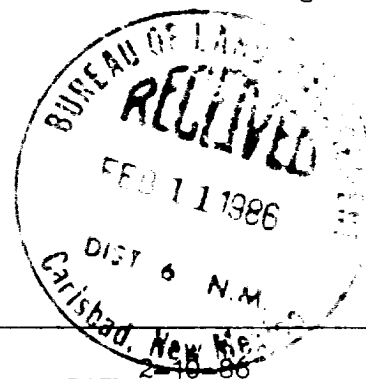

- (c) Spot 100' cmt. plug 50' above-below the top of the Queen at 2138'
- (d) Spot 100' cmt. plug 50' above-below the top of the 7-Rivers at 1438'
- (e) Spot 100' cmt. plug 50' above-below the Base of Salt at 996'
- (f) Spot 200' cmt. plug 100' above-below the Top of Salt at 320'
(Base of 8-5/8" at 306'-Plug will cover shoe 86' above and 114' below)
- (g) 50'- cmt. plug at surface with regulation marker
- (h) Clean location and notify BLM-Roswell ready for inspection

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

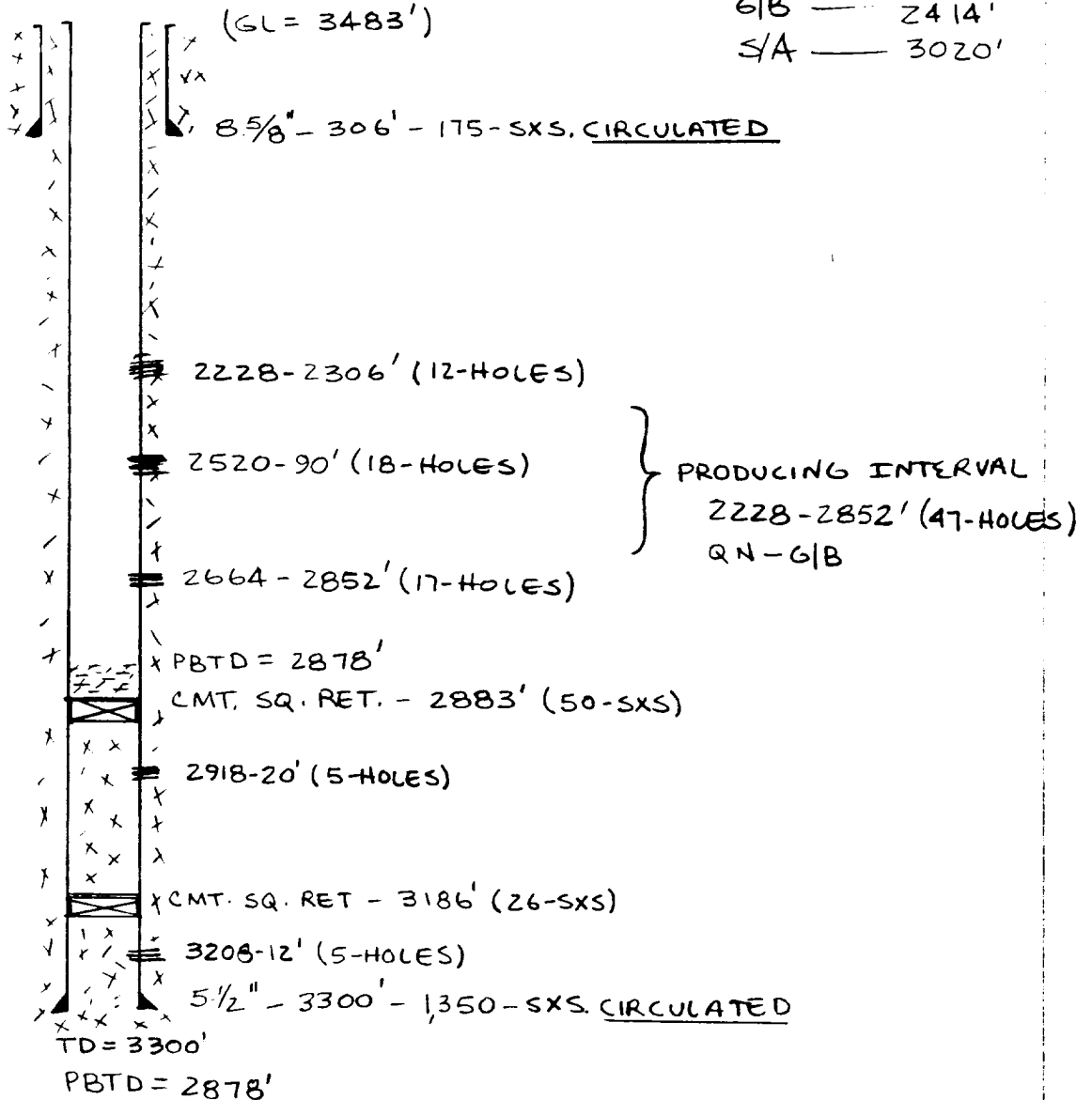
