

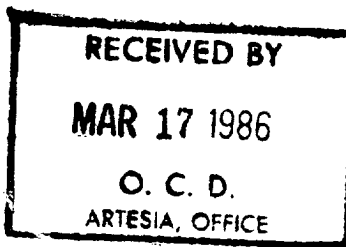

Statement by Applicant Under Oath:

The surface drilling of the well for which I seek a determination was begun on or after February 19, 1977; the well satisfies any applicable federal or state well-spacing requirements; and the well is not within a proration unit: which was in existence at the time the surface drilling of the well began; which was applicable to the reservoir from which such natural gas is produced; and which applied to any other well which either produced natural gas in commercial quantities or the surface drilling of which was begun before February 19, 1977, and was thereafter capable of producing natural gas in commercial quantities. I have concluded to the best of my information, knowledge, and belief, the natural gas for which I seek a determination is produced from a new, onshore production well and the basis for such conclusion. I have no knowledge of any other information not described in the application which is inconsistent with my conclusions.
