It is desired to perform a small re-frac pumping only curable resin-coated sand to stop wellbore entry of the Ottawa sand from the original frac job. This well was originally stimulated with a frac job of similar nature to other UTP operated North Shugart field wells in Sections 5 and 6. None of the wells completed to date have had the sever sand production problems experienced in this well although, through further production experience, wells in Section 6 have demonstrated a tendency to produce more frac sand than wells in Section 5.
