4-16-98 - Moved in pulling unit and plugging equipment. Shut down due to high winds.
4-18-98 - Rigged up pulling unit. Nippled down wellhead and nipped up hydril and line spooler. POOH with 57 joints 2-7/8" tubing to part at body of tubing. RIH with tubing and nipped down hydril. Nippled up and packed off wellhead. Rigged down pulling unit.
4-21-98 - Moved in and rigged up pulling unit to fish sub pump. Nippled down wellhead and installed hydril. TOOH with 2-7/8" tubing.
4-22-98 - TIH with overshot, 2 drill collars, jars and 2-7/8" tubing. Latched onto parted tubing at 2110'. Picked up on fish and set jars off. TOOH with tubing, jars, drill collars, overshot, 2-7/8" tubing below overshot, red cable and subpump. TIH with 2-7/8" tubing open ended to 7840'. Removed BOP and nipped up wellhead. Rigged down pulling unit.
4-23-28-98 - Waiting on plugging equipment.
4-29-98 - Moved in and rigged up pulling unit and plugging equipment. Nippled down wellhead and nipped up BOP. POOH with 2-7/8" tubing and seating nipple. TIH with CIBP and tubing. Shut down.
4-30-98 - Finished RIH with CIBP and tubing. Set CIBP at 7600'. Circulated hole with mud laden fluid. Spot 25 sack Class C cement from 7600-7354'. Pulled up hole. Spotted 35 sacks Class C cement from 6782-6137'. Pulled up hole. Spotted 35 sacks Class C cement
