

MULTI-POINT SURFACE USE AND OPERATIONS PLAN

LARUE & MUNCY

This plan is submitted with form 9-331-c, Application for Permit to Drill, covering the above described well. The purpose of this plan is to describe the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan, the magnitude of surface disturbance involved, and the procedures to be followed in rehabilitating the surface after completion of the operations, so that a complete appraisal can be made of the environmental effect associated with the operation.

1. EXISTING ROADS.

Exhibit A is a portion of a USGS topographic map showing the wells and roads in the vicinity of the proposed location.

2. PLANNED ACCESS ROAD.

Approximately 460 feet of road will have to be built from the main road.

DIRECTIONS.

Proceed east from Loco Hills to county road 222. Go south approximately 7 miles, turn west 4.5 miles. Turn south $\frac{1}{2}$ mile new road will start and go east to location

3. LOCATION OF EXISTING WELLS.

There is no existing wells on this 40 acres.

4. LOCATION OF EXISTING/OR PROPOSED FACILITIES

If productive, Production facility will be located on the drill pad

5. LOCATION AND TYPE OF WATER SUPPLY.

It is planned to drill the proposed well with a brine water system. The water will be obtained from commercial sources and will be hauled to the location by truck.

6. SOURCE OF CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS.

The location and road will be scraped out to caliche.
