Mr. Gum:

Texaco Exploration and Production Inc. requests an exemption from the Gas Well Shut-In Pressure Report for 1995 for the above well. This well is currently averaging 55 oil, 6050 MCF, and 30 BWPD. Considering the well's significant gas production, if the twenty-four hour shut-in pressure test is conducted, both TEPI and the State of New Mexico will realize lost revenues. In addition to the lost revenue, there is the possibility of killing the well while it is shut-in for the pressure test. This would mean additional downtime and swabbing costs.


