Drilled 12-1/2" hole to 380'. Run 9 jts 8-5/8" J55 24# casing and set at 372' and cemented with 250 sxs. Cl C w/2% CaCl₂ followed by 100 sxs Cl C w/2% CaCl₂. Circulated 120 sxs to pit. Plug down @ 2:00 P.M. (MST), 12/19/94.² WOC. Test BOP and casing to 1000 psi for 30 minutes, held OK. Shut down operations until 12/26/94.
