
Dear Mr. Buttross:

Reference is made to your application dated March 2, 1998 for an unorthodox oil well location in the Red Lake Queen-Grayburg-San Andres Pool for the proposed Evarts "6" Federal Well No. 4 (API No. 30-015-30109) to be drilled 330 feet from the North line and 1190 feet from the East line (Lot 1/Unit A) of Section 6, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, whereby Lot 1 of said Section 6 is to be dedicated to said well to form a standard 40.96-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool.
