Reference is made to the following: (i) your joint application dated May 10, 2000 filed on behalf of **The Wiser Oil Company** ("Wiser") and **W. A. & E. R. Hudson, Inc.** ("Hudson"); (ii) a letter of application from Mr. E. Randall Hudson, III dated April 18, 2000; (iii) a telephone conversation on April 24, 2000 between Mr. Michael E. Stogner, Engineer with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (ADivision) in Santa Fe and Mr. E. Randall Hudson, III; and (iv) the records of the Division in Santa Fe: all concerning both Wiser's and Hudson's request to drill the following described five wells at unorthodox oil well locations along lease-lines separating three waterflood projects within the Grayburg-Jackson Pool in Township 17 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico:
