Dear Steve,

I'm writing this letter not to ' spout out regulatory issues', but to have a better communication between the NMOCD and your company.

In regards to our conversation Wednesday concerning the above referenced well, I need to alert you to additional regulatory issues.

Whenever an operator intends to complete a well to a different zone whether it is a newly drilled well or a well that has previously produced from another zone, certain forms need to be approved by the NMOCD before work is to begin.

In this case for the Loco Hills Well #5, a proposal to plug back to another zone should have been submitted to our office and filed on Form C-101 and Form C-102, before work was to commence. We then could have reviewed the procedures and alerted your staff that the location of the well was non-standard for an oil well.

Rule 1102.D. and Rule 1103.A.(e) goes into specifics on the correct procedures.
