

DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to deepen this well with rotary tools from 5883'-9800' and test the Pennsylvanian. If commercial production is found, 5 1/2" casing will be run according to USGS specifications.

This well was formerly the Monsanto Chemical Company, Standard "MA" #1. 8 5/8" casing is set at 1013' with 1000 sacks cement.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
