Set 3 sacks cement on bottom and filled hole with mud to 670, set bridge and 5 sacks cement, filled hole with mud to 540 and set bridge and 5 sacks cement, filled hole with mud to surface and set regulation marker. We recovered 420' of 7" csg, 380' of 5½" csg and 315' of 3¼" csg.
