DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Drilled TD 4796' 2/3/52 - Carried out plan of testing dolomite formation and plugging as follows: Acidized (with Lynes Straddle packers) 3795-3882 - 1,000 gals. dry; acidized 2586-2623 - 1,000 gals. show oil, permanently abandoned lower section of hole up to 2730' by mudding and setting Baker open hole bridge plug at 2730' w/6' oil-seal plug on top; Acidized 2561-2628 - 2,000 gals. w/ show oil and water. Suspended operations by temporary abandonment, leaving surface casing cemented in well at 1019', with swedge and valve in top of 10 3/4" Casing.
