Gentlemen:

Reference is made to the subject named test drilled to a total depth of 1127', and temporarily abandoned on April 25, 1956. We have been advised that Mr. Charles Gaskins has obtained permission from the Conservation Commission to use the small amount of gas available from this hole to power irrigation equipment and other uses on his farm, and that the well is not capable of commercial production. We have acquired an oil and gas lease covering this tract and wish to inquire whether or not the present use of the gas from this test will affect any future gas allowable from this leasehold estate. We will appreciate your comment relative to this matter.
