Gentlemen:

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On February 15, 1960, the District Supervisor of the
Oil Conservation Commission in Artesia, New Mexico, Mr. M. L.
Armstrong, requested that you immediately submit certain
delinquent forms (C-103 and C-105) on the subject well.

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Mr. Armstrong also advised that since the well is in
an Artesian water basin it should be plugged immediately. You
have apparently ignored the correspondence from the Commission's
District Supervisor and this we will absolutely not tolerate.

You will submit these forms within one week so that
our District Supervisor can determine whether the well needs
immediate plugging. Failure to do so will result in immediate
legal action against you and the surety company on the bond to
plug the subject well.
