DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Set 10 sack cement plug at 3100' and filled hole with heavy mud using 200 sacks commercial mud. Placed 10 sack cement plug in bottom of cemented 8" casing at 1040'. The 8" casing was knocked off at collar and pulled at 700', indications were that cement came up around 8" casing to 720'. Tubing was run in hole and a 15 sack cement plug was spotted at 480' and another 25 sack cement plug was run at 350'. A 5 sack cement plug with 4" pipe marker was placed at surface.
