FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Rotary drilling was abandoned at 874' account of lost circulation at this depth. It was necessary to set 310' of 10" casing on shoulder through caving gravel zone in order to be able to continue drilling with cable tools. Drilling was continued with cable tools and on April, 21, 1949 new seamless 8 5/8" 18# casing was cemented at 972' with 35 sacks cement preceded by 185 sacks of commercial mud, using Halliburton equipment. We intend to drill plug and test casing and water shut off the morning of April, 25, 1949.
