DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED
 On August 25, 1949, hole was filled with mud from former plug back depth of 2176' to 2078' and bridge set on top of 7" liner at 2078'. A 12 sack cement plug was run on top of this bridge, then hole was filled with heavy commercial mud to 1015'. Bridge was set and a 12 sack cement plug was run from 1015' to 955' this plug cementing below and in 8 5/8" casing cemented at depth of 972'. The cement plug in bottom of 8" casing was found to be holding when tested with head of water. Top of 8" casing was capped with heavy 8" to 2" swage and 2" plug made up tight with heavy tools.
