To estimate 1500 feet or oil or water in the Grayburg formation unless commercial production encountered at a lesser depth. 2 joints 10" cemented 5' to be set to shut off water encountered above 900'. If in event commercial production is encountered, 7' to be set and cemented. I agree to again contact the Artesia U.S.G.S. office for confirmation before using either 5' or 7' casing as above mentioned. Final approval of this location has already been received from E. L. Sparrow, Director, Oil Conservation Commission. Written consent from Blanche E. Tving effecting lease holder under L. O. 06314 (being 1/4 Section 22, Township 19 South, Range 27 East) has been obtained and submitted with proper written application for approval of location to E. L. Sparrow.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
