DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

As witnessed by Mr. Justin Newman: Total depth of hole was 1913 feet. 8 5/8" casing was cemented at 190'. 7" casing was cemented at 836', and 5 1/2" casing was cemented at 850'. 5" casing was pulled from 760', 7" casing was pulled from 746' and 30' of 8 5/8" casing was pulled. Hole was mudded to surface and 15' sax cement plug set at 1650 ft., 5 sax cement plugs set at 800' and 600', using tubing to spot plugs. Regulation marker set and location abandoned.
