we plan to re-enter the Standard of Texas, Federal 1-9 #1 (an abandoned dry hole) and clean out to 2900 feet. ~~XXXX~~ Should bailing tests show no oil or gas from the open hole, we will plug back, perforate 1440' - 1450' in the Grayburg formation, acidize, and test. In the event commercial production is not encountered, we will re-plug the well as prescribed by the State Water Engineer. Preceding plan was verbally approved by Mr. Robert F. Evans on Dec. 15, 1958.
