Re; Properly Abandoned Wells.

The State of New Mexico is in the process at this time of reviewing leases to determin the number of abandoned and shut in wells.

Rule 201 A. states " The operator of any well drilled for oil, gas or injection, for seismic, core or other exploration, or for a service well, whether cased or uncased, shall be responsible for the plugging thereof."

Rule 201 B. A well shall be either properly plugged and abandoned or temporarily abandoned in accordance with these rules within {90} days after {1} a 60 day period following suspension of drilling.  $\{2\}$  A determination that the well is no longer usable for beneficial purposes. (3) A period of 1 year in which a well has been continuously inactive.

House Bill 65 has been passed by the legislature and provides some tax incentives for wells put back in production. However, if there are no plans to put a well or wells back in service then plugging or proper temporarily abandonment will be required

Please fordward to the Oil Conservation Division office in Artesia by November 15 a plan to bring the following list of wells into complience with rule 201. Failure to respond to this request will result in us asking our legal department to schedule a hearing so that you may appear and show cause why these wells should not be plugged.
