Dear Mr. Porter:

Drilling was completed on the well shown above on October 25, 1959, but no allowable has been requested. Total depth of the well is 2240', plug back depth is 2195', 3-5/8" casing is set at 620' w/150 sx and 5-1/2" casing is set at 2240' w/400 sx. Tubing depth is 1793'.

This well is perforated in the Seven Rivers zone from 1234' to 1240' and in the lower Queen zone from 1773' to 1785'. The operator wishes to isolate the Seven Rivers zone by setting a Quiberson AF tension type packer between the tubing and the 5-1/2" casing at 1350', and produce the Queen only.

Mr. Carl Smith, Superintendent for John H. Hill, discussed this matter with Mr. Armstrong in Artesia and he suggested that since he could not give Mr. Smith approval to do this, an application be made to the Oil Commission, with notification to the offset operators.

A plat of the areas attached. By copy of this letter notification is being made, through registered mail, to the operators listed below.

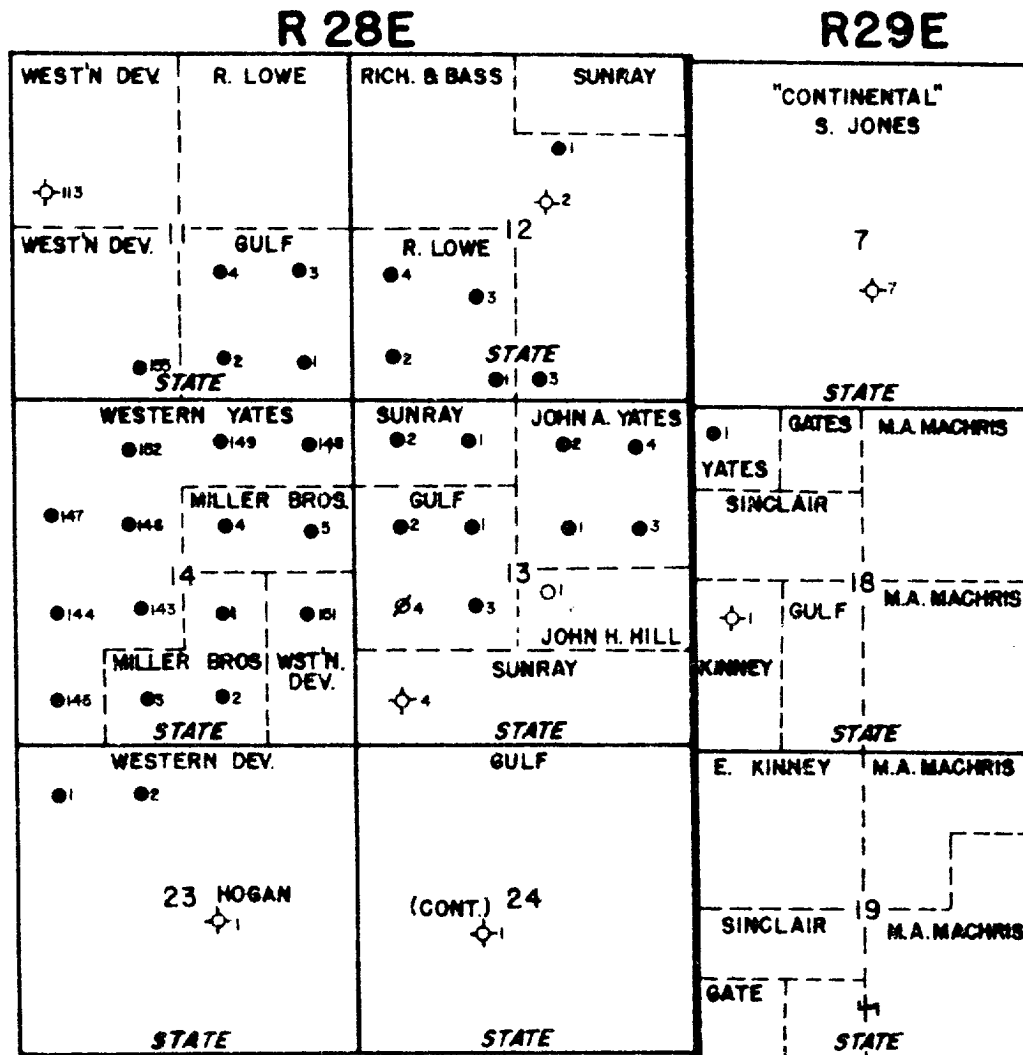
