Ran 70 jts (2186') 4-1/2" OD 9.50# J-55 SS casing. Set and cemented at 2197' with 330 sacks cement (4%). Plug at 2164'. Maximum pressure 1400#. Circulated approximately 75 sacks cement. Job complete January 1, 1959, 7:30 p.m.

After waiting over 30 hours, tested 4-1/2" casing with 1000# for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Drilled plug from 2164' to 2193'. Tested with 800# for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure.
