Sept 18, 1958 Begin drilling operations with cable tools Reach & Shepard.

Sept. 21, 1958 At T. D. 612' in anhy., ran 612' of new seamless 10 3/4" J-55, 32.75' csg. and cemented with 100 sacks neat cement / 3% C.C. added to cement slurry. After waiting on cement 36 hrs., drilled plug and bailed hole dry and tested 1 hr. and water shut off was complete. Now drilling ahead at 794' in anhy. Had 5 bailers of water per hr. at 250'. Top of salt at 430'. Base of salt at 608'.
