October 17, 1958 Ran 1877' of 8 5/8" casing to shut off savings and the Queen sand oil in order to drill ahead since we had a hole full of oil, mud and emulsion.

November 1 and 2, 1958 At. T. D. 2986', had 500 feet of salt water in hole, we knocked off 8 5/8" esg. one joint from bottom of string and pulled 1847' of 8 5/8" esg. and dumped savings from back of 8 5/8" into lower portion of hole then ran tools and cleaned out to 2596' and ran 2596' of new 5 1/2" 14# seamless casing with Howee formation packer shoe and cemented with 250 sacks neat cement. Plug down at 9: p.m., November 2, 1958. Now waiting on cement.
