DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well was drilled to total depth of 3015' in lime and plugged to 2725' without encountering oil or gas in commercial quantities. Plugging was done in the following manner:
 Plugged back with cement to 2600'. Hole was filled with 12# mud from 2600' to 1688'. After salvaging 1138' of 7" casing, a 12# plug was placed from 1688' to 1588'. Hole was filled with 12# mud to 10' from surface. Cemented to surface. A marker was erected and location restored to its original condition.
