DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well was drilled to total depth of 2150' in lime and plugged to 2525' without encountering oil or gas in commercial quantities.

Plugging was done in the following manner:

Plugged back with cement to 1800'. Hole was filled with 12# mud from 2500' to 1800'. After relieving 435' of 7" casing, a 12# mud plug was placed from 1800' to 1500'. Hole was filled with 12# mud to 10' from surface. Cemented to surface. A marker was erected and well was restored to its original condition.
