Ran tbg to T.D. (1156'). Filled hole with sand. Pulled tbg. to 1100' and ran cement plug 1100' to 1000' (35 sz). Pulled tbg. to 400' and ran cement plug 400' to 300' (35 sz). Salvaged top joint of 2 5/8" csg. (Casing remaining in hole from 24' to 345'). Regulation marker and cement is at location and will be set when rig is moved. Will advise U.S.G.S. when marker is set. P&H 12:00 Noon Feb. 15, 1962.
