Robinson Bros. Drilling Company wish to report that natural gas from our Williamson State "A" No. 1 well in the Winchester Field, Eddy County, New Mexico was used as drilling fuel by Marcum Drilling Company to drill the Shell Federal No. 2 operated by Estoril Producing Corporation.

Permission to use this gas was secured from Phillips Petroleum Company, purchaser of gas from the Williamson State "A" No. 1 by J. C. Williamson and D. W. Underwood. J. C. Williamson and D. W. Underwood are joint interest owners in the Williamson State "A" No. 1 well and also joint interest owners in the Shell Federal No. 2 well operated by Estoril Producing Corporation.

The gas connection on the Williamson State "A" No. 1 well was made downstream from the Phillips Petroleum Co. gas meter. Therefore, attached to this letter is a letter from Marcum Drilling Company stating the fuel consumption of this drilling rig.

The gas used by this drilling rig for drilling operations was 168 MCF per day and used for 42 days. Total consumption of fuel was 7,056 MCF.
