Your request for T.A. Status cannot be granted until the conditions of Rule 203 are met. Please submit a form C-103 indicating how you wish to T.A. the well if this is your preference, otherwise contact this office for the MIT to be rescheduled.

In the event that a satisfactory response is not received to this letter of direction by 17 July, 2002,

further enforcement will occur. Such enforcement may include this office applying to the Division for an order summoning you to a hearing before a Division Examiner in Santa Fe to show cause why you should not be ordered to permanently plug and abandon this well. Such a hearing may result in imposition of **CIVIL PENALTIES** for your violation of OCD rules.
