PURPOSE

Effective from the date of the first production of oil in the district.

Heavy oil is defined as oil having a gravity of less than 20 degrees API.

Light oil is defined as oil having a gravity of 20 degrees API or more.

Oil is defined as any liquid hydrocarbon which is capable of being produced from a well.
