Dear Mr. Stamets:

In reference to your letter of June 7, 1968, in regard to certain of our wells located in Eddy County, New Mexico, please be informed as follows:

State F #12-B, 23-18-27, and
State G #13-A, 23-18-27,


are both off production at the present time, and the allowables should be removed beginning July 1968.

In regard to Samwell #1-B, 15-19-29, on our Turkey Track leases, we are in the process of some remedial work to restore this well to production, and as soon as this work is completed, we will file a C-103 requesting the allowable on this well be left as is. Our delay in getting this well back on production has been occasioned by the fact of new management personnel within the company coupled with movement and consolidation of the company's offices. However, we hope to have this well back on production within the next day or so.
