DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

We set Lane Wells Bridging plug at 2335, perforated casing at 2334 and 2135, set Halliburton bridging plug at 2143 on tubing and squeezed 15 sacks of cement from 2334 up to 2135 let cement set 72 hours, Drilled out upper bridge plug.

Ran Lane Wells Gamma Ray and Neutron log, perforated 60 shots 2212 to 2232.

Treated with 10,000 gallons FAMARISS oil with 1500 lb. sand and flushed with 90 bbls. oil on March 19th, 1955

Let set overnight, installed pumping equipment, After recovering load, treating and flushing oil by March 29th, 1955 well now pumping 18 bbls. oil and 10 bbls. of water per day.

This well formerly only well in the SANTO NINO pool has now been plugged back and is producing from the Queen sand and is in the East Turkey Track Pool.

This well now pumping 6 bbls. per day.
