This well was T. A. 10/8/64 and a subsequent T. A. was approved 10/24/67. It was T. A. because the production had declined to the point where it was not economical to produce. However, due to the increase in the price of oil, we plan further development on this lease as soon as we are able to secure the necessary equipment. It is possible that the pay in this field will respond to secondary recovery by water flooding and the use of this well would be essential in any such operation. Therefore, we ask that a T. A. for a period of two years be approved or until this well is put into active use, whichever is the lesser.

The well is shut in with 2" valve on tubing and required sign in place.

## Instructions

**General:** This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

**Item 4:** If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

**Item 17:** Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
