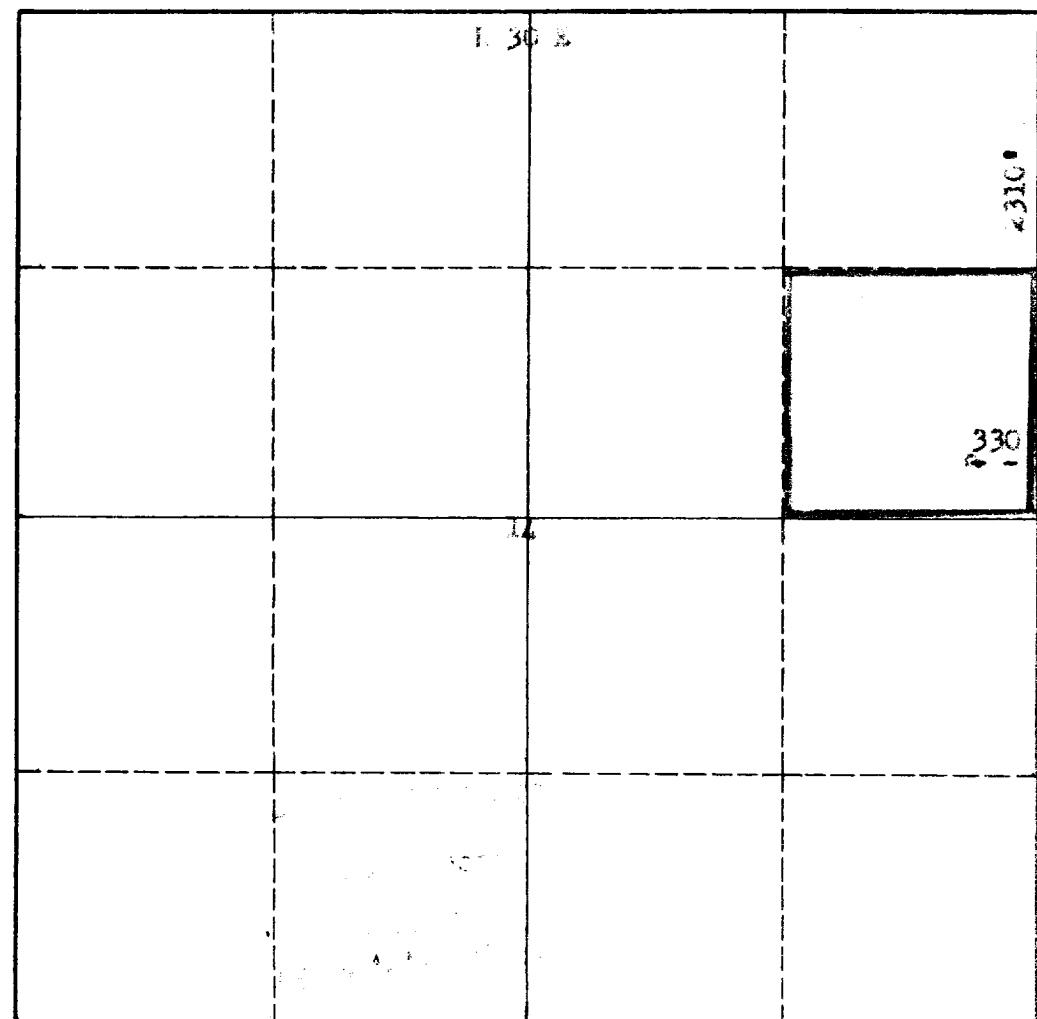

Reference is made to your Notice of Intention to Drill Southern California Petroleum Corporation Federal well No. 1 (copy attached) SE1/4 sec. 14, T. 19 S., R. 30 E., N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, on lease New Mexico 01085. Inasmuch as the lease lies within the potash area designated by the order of the Secretary of the Interior dated October 16, 1951, the Director, U. S. Geological Survey must approve the drilling of all shallow wells on the lease.
