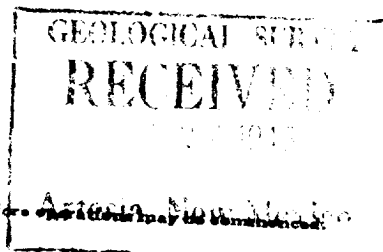

DETAILS OF WORK

On or about June 24, 1946, we expect to start drilling a well at the above location to an approximate depth of 2,000 ft., unless oil or gas in commercial quantities is encountered at a lesser depth. We propose to run 28 lb. 8 1/2" casing on the top of the salt or immediately above at approximately 350 ft., and cement with 50 sacks of cement and circulate mud to the surface. If oil is encountered in sufficient quantities, we expect to set approximately 1800 ft. of 17 lb. 7" casing as an oil string, cement with 100 sacks of cement and circulate mud to the surface.

We expect to abide by U.S.G.S. rules and regulations.
