This letter will acknowledge receipt of your Forms C-104, Request for Oil Allowable, and Form C-123, Request for Creation of a New Pool. Before we can approve your request for an allowable we must have a set of Form C-103's on running and cementing of surface casing and test for water shut off and the same reports on the 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing. You may include your report of casing perforations, acid and fracture treatment on the 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing report. Also we want one copy of the electric log. As soon as you have arranged for a pipe line connection or transporter, file the Forms C-110 and we will enter their name on the Form C-104's and forward same to the proration manager at Hobbs.

You have 20 days after completion of a well in which to file Form C-105, Well Record. All necessary forms are enclosed.
