Inasmuch as the Form C-103's filed on the subject well reflect that it was not plugged in accordance with the provisions of Order No. R-111-A dealing with the potash-oil area, and since the Potash Company of America was not notified prior to plugging operations, it will be necessary for you to drill out the plugs and replug the well in accordance with the program set forth in Order No. R-111-A.

Before commencing the replugging operations, offset lessees, including potash lessees, are to be notified of the date and time of plugging operations. In addition, the Commission's District Office in Artesia is to be so notified.
