Gentlemen:

With further reference to the above-captioned well, I discussed the matter fully with Mr. Armstrong of our Artesia office and have been advised by him that, after he had approved the C-102, Notice of Intention to Plug, he contacted your office by telephone and advised that the well must not be plugged until both the Commission and Potash Company of America had been notified as to the exact time of the scheduled plugging operation, so that both a potash company representative and a Commission agent could be present to witness the plugging. All plugging operations in the potash-oil area are witnessed by a Commission agent, and offsetting potash lessees must be given the opportunity to do so.

Though your letter states that the well was sold to Hobbs Pipe and Supply Company, we have no record of such a transfer, either on Form C-103 or Form C-110, the only two forms that are used for such a purpose. Anyway we could not have approved the acquisition of the well by Hobbs Pipe and Supply Company, since they do not have a plugging bond on file with the Commission.
